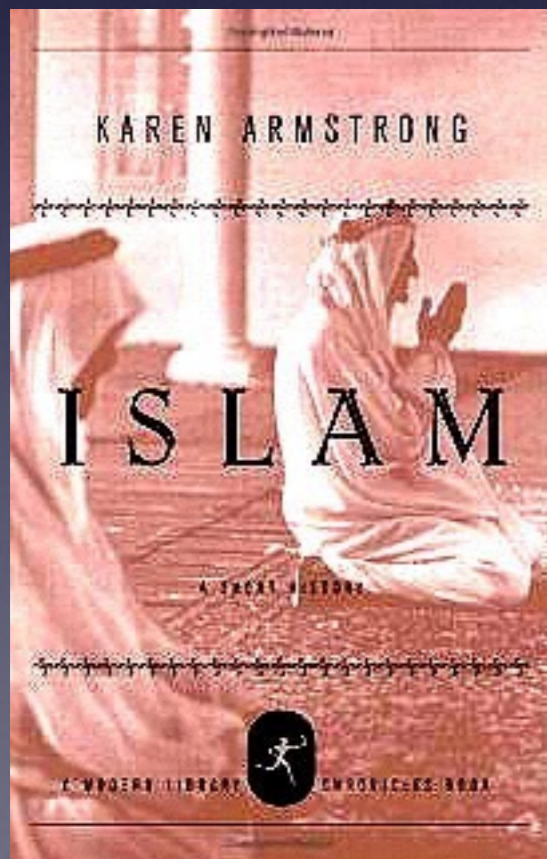

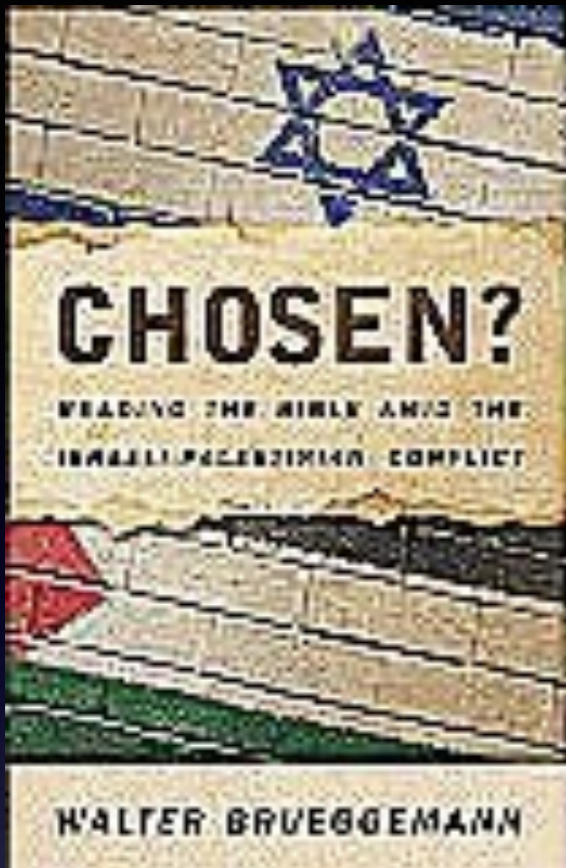

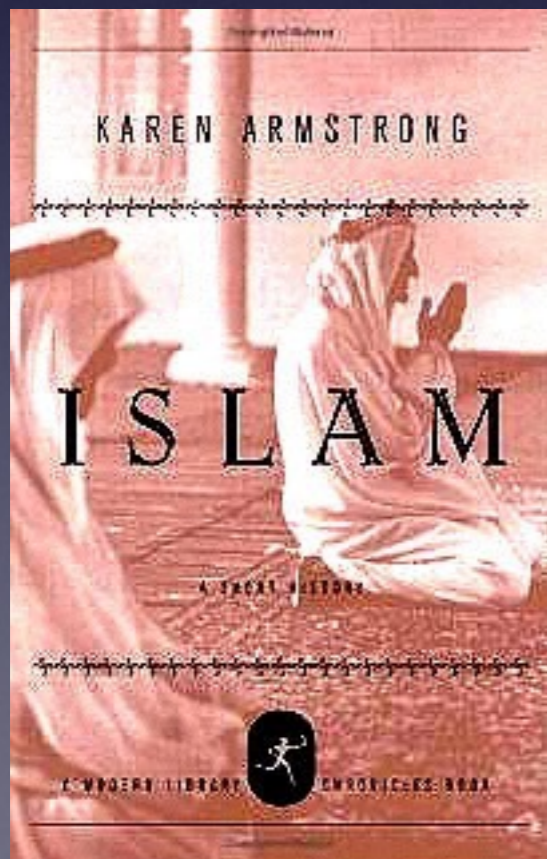

BriefBio - Walter Breuggemann

- influential Hebrew Bible (OT) scholar and theologian
- Th.D from Union Theological Seminary, NY
- Ph.D from St Louis University
- 7 honorary degrees.
- Ordained in the United Church of Christ (now affiliated with United Church of Canada)
- 58 books
- accuses Israel of “toxic ideology vv the Palestinians
- known for combining literary and sociological modes
- contributor to “Living the Questions” study group.

- ex-nun, ex-tv reporter
- Oxford - English Literature
- author of 25 books on religious subjects.
- winner of a \$100,000 TED prize.
- used prize to found The Charter for Compassion
- scholar, lecturer, advocate, dissident
- described as “arguably the most lucid, wide-ranging and consistently interesting religion writer today”

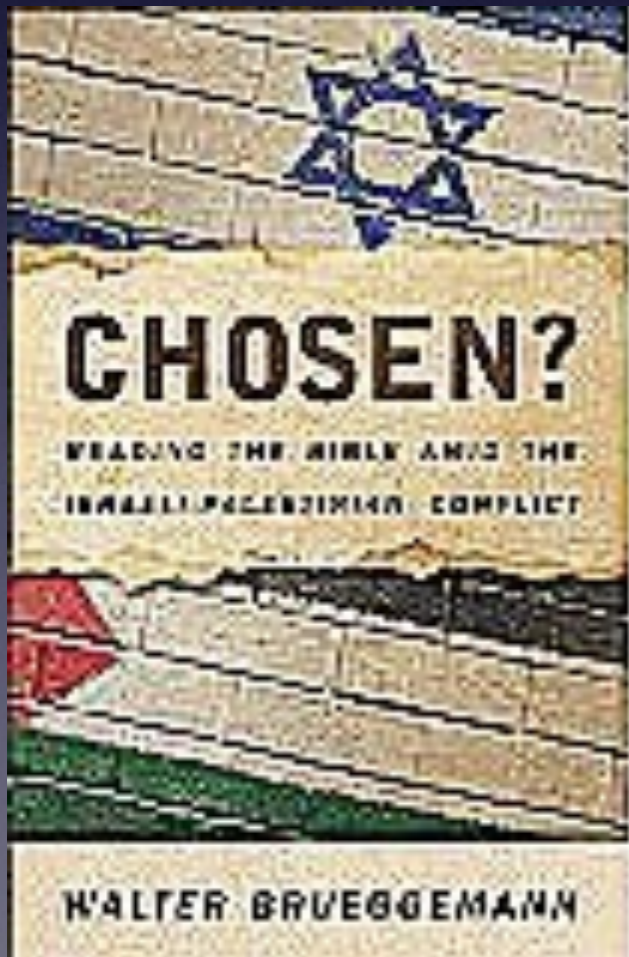
