This Psalter Choir is composed of members of the Protestant Reformed Churches in America



Source book of temple and synagogue worship




A mixed blessing -

Proverbs/Ecclesiastes/Song of Solomon

What can be done to recover the best for our times? Consider books like Jim Taylor's "Everyday Psalms"


God has walked with me; I could ask nothing more.

Why was Wisdom included with Law and Prophets in the Hebrew Scriptures?



Sophia - "wisdom" in Greek

- a feminine term
- value recovered in an era of gender justice
- Hagia Sophia in Istanbul



"Good living can be rewarded in this life"
Hebrews lacked a concept of the afterlife



Ecclesiastes - Quoheleth - "the preacher" both cynical and hopeful theolog "All is vanity" "To everything there is a season"



Song of Solomon - bawdy songs or spiritual rhapsodies? Should a book like this be included in the canon?





Song of Solomon appears in the Greek Septuagint for the first time in 250 BCE


Is it theology?

Used to commemorate the death of the temple (**Festival of Ab**) or salvation from national genocide (**Purim**)




Liturgical Observance

- reflect on other faiths and secular thought
- was influencing Hebrew thinking



Lamentations - Living through loss



Esther - Saving one's people in critical times



"Our perception of truth evolves as human consciousness expands"




Chronicles, Ezra, Nehemiah

- Claiming identity and value as a people through association with "the land"
- survival and resilience
- a classic Hebrew theme still much debated today




Hebrew theological reflection - Not history as we know it




Nehemiah and Esther - 2nd century BCE

- Hebrew biblical canon closed

Apocrypha



Textual distinctives - led to the separation of Judaism and Christianity




